

Fig. 1 Current Transfer Ratio vs. Forward Current




Fig. 3 Collector Current vs.
Collector-emitter Voltage




Fig. 5 Collector-emitter Saturation
Voltage vs. Ambient Temperature




Fig. 2 Forward Current vs. Forward voltage




Fig. 4 Relative Current Transfer Ratio vs. Ambient Temperature




Fig. 6 Collector Dark Current vs. Ambient Temperature






Fig. 7 Forward Current vs.

Ambient Temperature




Fig. 8 Collector Power Dissipation vs.
Ambient Temperature





Fig. 9 Response Time vs. Load Resistance



Test Circuit for Response Time






Fig. 10 Frequency Response




Test Circuit for Frequency Response

* NOTES ON HANDLING

1.Recommended soldering conditions (Dip soldering)

(1) Dip soldering

Temperature 260°C or be bw (molten solder temperature)

Time Less than 10 seconds.

Cycle One cycle allowed to be dipped in solder including plastic mold portion.

Flux Rosin flux containing small amount of chlorine

(The flux with a maximum chlorine content of 0.2 Wt % is recommended.)

(2) Cautions

Fluxes

Avoid removing the residual flux with freon-based and chlorine-based cleaning solvent.

2. Cautions regarding noise

Be aware that power is suddenly into the componment any surge current may cause damage happen, even if the voltage is within the absolute maximum ratings.


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



